General Information

- * The sponsoring organization, and no other agent, must submit the official parade application and admin fee to Southern Nevada Association Of Pride, Inc. Parade committee to participate in the 2008 Pride Night Parade
- * Sponsoring organizations must agree to all Parade Rules & Regulations
- * Your signature on the parade application serves as a waiver of liability and indemnification agreement between all participants in your contingent and Southern Nevada Association of Pride, Inc.
- * Sponsor organization agrees to support the goals of Southern Nevada Association of Pride, Inc. as it is described in our mission statement
- * Nonprofits which are a 501(c)(3) organization qualify for the nonprofit admin fee
- * Verification of your 501(c)(3) status is required and must be submitted with your application to qualify for the nonprofit admin fee
- * Applications must be postmarked no later than **April 25, 2008**
- * All applications must be complete and the full admin payment must accompany applications in order to be considered for parade line up
- * Any request for specific placement in the parade line up must be noted in the designated area on page two of the Parade Application
- * All requests are subject to the approval by the Parade Committee
- * Line up consideration will be based on the order in which applications were received, so please send in your application as soon as possible
- * A representative of each Parade entry must attend a Mandatory Parade Meeting at 8 p.m. on Wednesday, April 30, 2007 at the Gay & Lesbian Community Center of Southern Nevada, 953 East Sahara Avenue, Suite B-31, Las Vegas, NV 89104

* All rules and regulations as well as line up requests will be reviewed and any questions you may have will be answered at the Mandatory Parade Meeting

* Parade line up will start at 5:00 p.m. and end at 6:30 p.m.

* Entries checked in after 6:30 p.m. will be bumped to the back of the parade

* Parade starts at 8:00 p.m. sharp

* Southern Nevada Association of Pride, Inc. will not accept responsibility for any loss of any kind due to fire, theft, crowd, nature, or other causes

Parade Decorating Tips

SNAPI recommends that you emphasize the decorations on your presentation with lighting. Lighting is mandatory because that's the point of having a night parade. If your presentation does not require lighting, you may want to consider using bright or neon colors, sequins, or mirrors to make your presentation more visible to our parade guests. Remember, all eyes are on you! Don't forget that glow lights come in all colors and sizes. Explore your lighting options before you make your final decision. Use your creativity to bring your entry to life. If you need help, don't hesitate to call SNAPI for ideas.
