- Freddy L Mass Mutual Freddy has submitted a dozen articles for financial wellness to be included in the Magazine; he is also partnering with his company to bring more sponsorship opportunities to PRIDE – details to come
- Stephanie O branding agency for web services Cast Design Team; interested in partnering with us
 - o James we will setup a meeting with Ernie and the Board to discuss
- Toshia M representing herself wanting a better PRIDE, specifically a better Festival, and better entertainment how do we do that?
 - James money we are working to drive more funds through sponsorship and through creative networks and connections;
 - James explains that our expansion of the Board and Associate Board is designed to help support our growth and networking;
 - James explains the we have been struggling to recover financially AND really deliver on profitability – we committed to not declare bankruptcy; and now we are solvent – working to raise capital;
- Jon R how does PRIDE spend money from LVCVA?
 - James the funds are LVCVA's funds they spend to have SNAPI represent the LVCVA they earmark all funds for specifically designated travel
- Garrett P representing AFAN as an experienced event presenter, he wants to help us; offered to switch up our Parade / Festival weekend format to drive more traffic
- Blue M questions transparency drive people to the Annual Meeting so they can get involved wants for us to make the invite to new members more welcoming and publicized;
- Blue M asks about Ernie's pay
 - James review's role as a non-board member; an external consultant; reviews his pay at \$3,000 per month for services rendered – BINGO, social media, marketing, magazine, sponsorship, events, etc
- Garrett P asks about Hamburger Mary's and involvement / marketing / relationship with PRIDE; asks if the same opportunities exist for other businesses
 - James explains our Sponsorship program; explains that Hamburger Mary's was PRIDE's single biggest financial contributor; as a representative
- Rob S thanks to Board for correcting misinformation he had seen on social media; reminds ALL BOARD MEMBERS to know our financials and be mindful of all of our expenditures
- Mike K representing Hamburger Mary's is disappointed to see the community have such resentment internally;
- Steve representing Orange County PRIDE;
- Von J how is Royalty selected? Why doesn't PRIDE have a Pagaent?
 - Misty Waves President of Royal Court explains that the Royal Court gifted the Titles to PRIDE – because they were not able to get candidates to fill the roles and funds were not raised
 - James invites Von to participate and bring his suggestions and input to our committees constructively
- James recaps by inviting interested individuals to get involved and offer help and contribute positively to PRIDE because it's bigger than any individual none of us claim to be experts and
